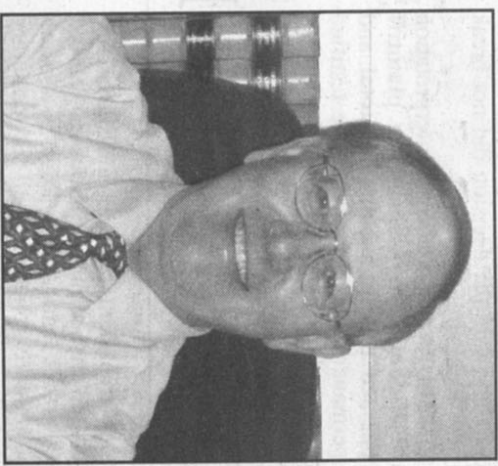


Australian Dean Picked To Head Charlotte Law School

The Charlotte School of Law and the Infilaw Consortium of Independent Law Schools last week appointed Dr. E. Eugene Clark as dean of the city's first law school, which is scheduled to open in August 2006. He will assume the deanship in January 2006, a release said.

Dr. Clark is currently dean of the School of Law, Business and Arts at Charles Darwin University in Australia. Most recently, he served two terms as head of the law school at the University of Canberra, as well as five years as pro vice-chancellor. He has also taught at the University of Tasmania, the University of New Mexico and the University of the South Pacific.

Dr. Clark holds five degrees including doctorates in Law from both the U.S. and Australia, and masters degrees

in education from Australia and the U.S. He is one of two law professors

selected for Australia's inaugural National Teaching Excellence Awards.

"Dean Clark is an accomplished legal expert and a well respected professor and author," said Shirley Fulton who chairs the Charlotte School of Law board of trustees and is a partner in a Charlotte law firm. "He also has a leadership style and operational background that will be critical in the success of Charlotte Law."

Clark is also one of Australia's most published law academics having authored, co-authored or edited 20 books and hundreds of journal articles on different aspects of e-business, e-government, commercial law and legal education.

The Charlotte School of Law will have a full-time program and flexible day and evening part-time programs for working professionals, the release said
