New dean at Charlotte School of Law

Charlotte School of Law is getting a new dean, school officials have announced.

Dean Eugene Clark has been named interim dean of the Arizona-based Phoenix School of Law, effective immediately. The schools are both members of the InfiLaw System, a group of independent law schools.

Dennis Stone, who is currently vice president of operations for the InfiLaw System, has been appointed interim dean at the Charlotte school, officials said. Stone, who has 30 years experience in legal education, served as the school's interim dean before Clark's appointment in 2006, school officials said.

Charlotte School of Law opened in August 2006 and received provisional American Bar Association approval last June. The school has about 320 full- and part-time students.
